### **b. Foreign students** USD2000 **UNIVERSITY POLICY ON PAYMENT OF FEES**

University policy is such that fees is paid in full on the day of arrival. However, in order to accommodate those who cannot afford to pay fees in full at once, Management allows fees payment in three installments. The first tuition installment, which is due on arrival, is **50%** of the total tuition fees. The remaining balance should be paid as follows: **30%** in March and **20%** in April. The deadline for clearing fees balances is Friday **31<sup>st</sup> April 2017**
